

Volunteer Role Description



Title: incredABLE Youth Club Volunteer

What is involved?

Volunteers are required **once a week** (club night dependant) from **7.00pm – 9.00pm** to assist with the delivery of incredABLE Youth Club provision. The clubs (targeting young people who are currently isolated from social opportunities or who, have complex needs) take place in centres in Craigavon, Richhill, Banbridge, Keady, Newry and Dungannon and offer a platform for socialising and befriending. Co-ordinated by a Youth Club Leader in Charge and Youth Support Worker, each club aims to deliver between 50-80 hours of youth club programming/volunteer hours annually.

Core Objective:

To work within the incredABLE Youth Programming team to ensure youth club members participate in a wide range of activities with their peers linked to the youth work curriculum and do so in a fun, friendly, safe and empowering environment.

Duties may include:

- Assisting with room/resource set up
- Offering 1-1 support to incredABLE Youth Club members if required
- Assisting with regular outings to chosen facilities
- Ensure members' safety by following organizational procedures (i.e Risk Assessment)
- Act as a liaison for Youth Club members and encourage the achievement of independence goals
- Being an incredABLE Youth Club Ambassador- promoting the Youth Club in a positive and empowering manner
- Communicate any concerns with the Youth Leader in Charge/ Project Coordinator e.g. incidents/accidents etc

What is expected of you?

As an incredABLE Youth Club volunteer it is desirable that you have experience in youth work or youth programming or have a real passion for working with young people. You will be expected to familiarise yourself with each club's youth programme outcomes and the vision, mission and values of incredABLE and carry out your role to the standard specified by the organisations volunteer rights and responsibilities code.

Useful Skills: Previous youth programming experience/Youth work qualification, organisation, creative thinking, event planning, arts & crafts

What support will you get?

Induction Training: Once you have completed the application process you will receive Induction training on the work of incredABLE including opportunities for further engagement.

Volunteer training: Access to incredABLE training throughout the year (e.g. Safeguarding/Disability Awareness)

Volunteer Expenses: Out of pocket expenses (e.g, mileage, food and beverages) as pertaining to your role.
